Lead Service Line Inventory

The US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) recently released its Lead and Copper Rule Revisions, which aims to safeguard public health by ensuring that all water systems develop and maintain comprehensive inventories of service line materials by October 16, 2024.

NE Sammamish Sewer & Water completed its inventory of drinking water pipes in the District. This includes all water service line materials, from the water main to the water meter (public side) and from the water meter to the house (private side). All water service lines have been determined to be **non-lead**.

The District determined this through a combination of methods, including the 1966 King County ban on lead as an approved material, district specifications, construction records and observations, customer self-reporting, statistical analysis, and field investigations.
